Congratulations on your book. Here's how we decide what goes on the new-book shelf, and how to start the process.

THE SHORT VERSION

- We're a used bookstore. Over 99% of our inventory is used.
- New books come from two main sources: Todd Communications and Ingram, plus a few national publishers.
- The book should look professional, on par with what's already on our shelves.
- The spine needs a title and author name, so it's findable on the shelf.
- We do not carry consignments.
- New books are purchased at a 40% wholesale discount.
- It should be well-edited and proofread.

Strengthen your case: the Alaska connection

We prioritize local authors, in part because it's easier to bring you in for a signing.

LOCAL SUBJECT

Is it about Alaska?

Alaskan themes, like homesteading, fishing, the outdoors, or dogsledding, sell well to our customers.

A yes to either one strengthens your submission. A yes to both is ideal.
